

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of The Board of Trustees Webster Groves Public Library September 20, 2017

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Webster Groves Public Library was held at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, September 20, 2017. President Nancy Marshall presided and Library Director Tom Cooper kept the minutes. Also present: Trustees Bob Hart, Bethany Curtis, Andrew Rushing, Joan Esserman, Bill Kuc, Justin Hauke, and Eliot Graf. Absent: Trustee Nicole Chaput and City Council Liaison Toni Hunt.

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m.

Public Agenda

There was no public agenda.

Minutes of the August 16, 2017 Meeting

Mr. Hauke moved to accept the minutes as presented, Ms. Curtis seconded, and the minutes were approved.

Mr. Rushing reviewed the financial report for the month of August. After two months of the new fiscal year we are now about \$9,000 under budget. Mr. Kuc moved to approve the financial report, Ms. Curtis seconded, and the report was approved.

<u>Old Business</u>

Mr. Cooper reported that in further conversation with our insurance broker, it appears that the Data Defender Coverage insurance discussed at the August meeting is not what we need. If anything, we could use Network Defender Coverage, which would reimburse us for expenses related to a malware attack or a ransomware attack. But that insurance, which costs significantly more than the Data Defender Coverage, also has a \$10,000 deductible, making it impractical for our needs. Discussion of this insurance is tabled.
