## TOP DRAWER



### *City of Webster Groves*

- highlights “present and proposed boundary” lines
- probably ca. 1896 – 1897

### *City of Webster Groves, Missouri, circa 1909*

- reprinted by Bopp Chapel, 2002
- reverse side features a copy of *City of Webster Groves, Saint Louis County, Missouri* drawn by Harold D. Kinder (updated by Gillum-Polk Associates Nov. 1981; May 25, 1983; April 12, 1993)

### *City of Webster Groves, Saint Louis County, Missouri*

- April 26, 1937
- shows residential, commercial, and industrial zones
- possibly drawn by Arthur de Grendon

### *City of Webster Groves, Saint Louis County, Missouri*

- December, 1944 revision by “R.A.M.” of above map
- includes bus lines and alphabetical street index
- reverse side features advertisements for local businesses
- published by Boy Scout Troop 300 in 1946

### *City of Webster Groves, Saint Louis County, Missouri*

- City Plan Commission, Harland Bartholomew and Associates
- drawn Feb. 1955, revised Sep. 20, 1956; Jul. 5, 1960; Nov. 6, 1962; Jul. 1968
- shows residential and commercial zones



### *City of Webster Groves, Saint Louis County, Missouri*

- June 4, 1963 revision of above map



### *East Part of Webster Groves and Vicinity*

- 1909 map of eastern Webster Groves (from approx. Selma Ave., Mason Ave., and Glen Rd.) and Shrewsbury
- see also *City of Webster Groves, Missouri, circa 1909* and *Webster Groves and Vicinity*



### *John C. Marshall's Estate, Webster Grove [sic]*

- map of lots to be sold at auction, May 25, 1870
- area depicted approximately between Berry Rd. and Elm Ave., and between Gore Ave. (Church Ave.) and Swon Ave.



### *Township 44 North Range 6 East of the 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian*

- from *Pitzman's New Atlas of the City and County of Saint Louis, Missouri*, 1878
- includes southern portion of present-day Webster Groves (from just south of Swon Ave.)
- includes parts of present-day Kirkwood, St. Louis City, Affton, Sappington, Jefferson Barracks
- shows names of landowners



### *Township 44 Range 6 East of the 5<sup>th</sup> pr<sup>l</sup> M<sup>d</sup>*

- possibly ca. 1862 (pencilled in at bottom)
- same area as above map
- shows names of landowners



### *Township 45 North Range 6 East of the 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian*

- from *Pitzman's New Atlas of the City and County of Saint Louis, Missouri*, 1878
- includes northern portion of present-day Webster Groves (from just south of Swon Ave.)
- depicts areas north of Webster Groves to around Olive Blvd., including present-day Rock Hill, Brentwood, Maplewood, Richmond Heights, Clayton, University City, and St. Louis City
- shows names of landowners



### *Webster*

- from *Pitzman's New Atlas of the City and County of Saint Louis, Missouri*, 1878
- shows names of subdivisions and landowners



### *Webster, A Subdivision of 109.06 Arpens*

- map of lots (in present-day Rock Hill) to be sold at auction, Oct. 2, 1867
- area depicted approximately between Berry Rd. and Elm Ave., and between Manchester Rd. and Lockwood Ave.



### *Webster Groves and Vicinity*

- same as *City of Webster Groves, Missouri*, circa 1909, but with subdivisions filled in with various colors
- includes both *East Part of Webster Groves and Vicinity* (see above) and *West Part of Webster Groves and Vicinity*

### *Webster Groves, Mo.*

- “Showing city blocks, subdivisions, & wards”
- published by R. E. McMath Surveying Co.
- dated August 1908



### *Webster Groves, Webster Station Pacific Rail Road*

- map of lots to be sold at auction, June 17, 1859
- area depicted approximately between Rock Hill Rd. and Elm Ave., and between Kirkham Ave. and Lockwood Ave.

## SECOND DRAWER

### *City of Webster Groves*

- same base map as *City of Webster Groves*, ca. 1896 – 1897
- shows ward boundaries, August 1897

### *City of Webster Groves, Saint Louis County, Missouri*

- drawn by Harold D. Kinder [probably early 1970s]
- reverse side features “Webster Groves Information Bulletin/Spring ’73”
- lists points of interest, churches, parks, schools, and a complete street index
- “Courtesy of Webster Groves Chamber of Commerce”



### *City of Webster Groves, Saint Louis County, Missouri*

- same as above, but updated by Gillum-Polk Associates Nov. 1981; May 25, 1983; [ca. 1993]



### *City of Webster, St. Louis County, Mo.*

- depicts Webster Groves and surrounding areas
- Fred Graf Engraving Co., 1908
- “Compliments of Kent Jarvis, Webster Groves Real Estate”



### *Map of Webster Park*

- created by Webster Park Realty Company (Charles A. Baker, agent)
- probably ca. 1904

*School District of Webster Groves, Mo.*

- dated Sep. 1, 1951
- left (west) half of map is missing



surveys of Gross Acres

- individual surveys of lots 2, 4, and 5 performed by Richard W. Halteman and Co. in August 1954
- located between Elm Ave. and Elm Dr., and between St. Georges Pl. and Ola Ave.
- two copies of lot 2 survey



untitled map of Webster Park

- from *An Atlas of St. Louis County in the State of Missouri*, 1893
- shows block and lot divisions
- includes blocks A, B, and C on west side of railroad tracks



*Webster Park, St. Louis County, Mo.*

- created by McCormick-Kilgen-Rule Real Estate Co. (Kent Jarvis, agent)
- includes blocks A, B, and C on west side of railroad tracks

*Insurance Maps of St. Louis, Missouri, Volume Ten*

- published by the Sanborn Map Company, 1903
- sheet 85 shows key to other Webster Groves maps from same volume
- approximate areas depicted include :
  - sheet 85 : southeast corner of Elm Ave. and Chestnut Ave., Lockwood Ave. near Selma Ave. and Joy Ave., and south side of Lockwood Ave. on both sides of Bompert Ave.
  - sheet 86 : between Missouri Pacific Railroad and W. Cedar Ave., and between Jefferson Rd. and Gore Ave.
  - sheet 87 : between Marshall Pl. and Lockwood Ave., and between Gore Ave. and Maple Ave.
  - sheet 88 : between Lockwood Ave. and a half-block south of Cedar Ave., and between S. Gore Ave. and S. Maple Ave.

- sheet 89 : between Kirkham Rd. and Missouri Pacific Railroad, and between a half-block west of Lincoln Ave. and a half-block east of N. Gore Ave.; also includes inset continuing Marshall Pl. to Elm Ave.
- sheet 90 : between the intersection of Big Bend Blvd. and Murdoch Ave., and between S. Old Orchard Ave. and Laclede Station Rd.; also includes inset continuing Big Bend Blvd. a half-block beyond Murdoch Ave.

*Insurance Maps of St. Louis Missouri, Volume Ten*

- published by the Sanborn Map Company, 1917
- sheet 85 shows key to other Webster Groves maps from same volume
- some sheets indicated on sheet 85 are unavailable
- approximate areas depicted include :
  - sheet 85 : between Lockwood Ave. and a half-block south of Garden Ave., and between just west of Plymouth Ave. and a half-block east of Bompert and Hazel Aves.; between a half-block south of Murdoch Ave. and a half-block south of Garden Ave., and between S. Old Orchard Ave. and Laclede Station Rd.
  - sheet 86 : between just south of Newport Ave. and Lockwood Ave. and between Bompert Ave. and a half-block east of Spring Ave.
  - sheet 87 : between a half-block east of Rock Hill Rd. and N. Maple Ave., and between just south of the intersection of Elm and Kirkham Aves. and Lockwood Ave.
  - sheet 88 : between Lockwood Ave. and a half-block south of Swon Ave., and between Jefferson Rd. and S. Maple Ave.
  - sheet 89 : between W. Cedar Ave. and the intersection of Big Bend Blvd. and Plant Ave., and between S. Maple Ave. and the intersection of Big Bend Blvd. and Bradford Ave.
  - sheet 90 : between a half-block south of Swon Ave. and just south of Chestnut Ave., and between Gray Ave. and S. Maple Ave.; between Frisco Railroad and just south of Chestnut Ave., and between Lizette Ave. and just east of Percival Ave.
